

Privacy Notice

Meadow Cottage Holiday Homes and Meadow Cottage Caravan and Motorhome Site

This notice explains what information I collect, when I collect it and how I use this. During the course of my activities, I will process personal data (which may be held on paper, electronically, or otherwise) about you and I recognise the need to treat it in an appropriate and lawful manner. The purpose of this notice is to make you aware of how I will handle your information.

Who am I?

I take the issue of security and data protection very seriously and strictly adhere to guidelines published in the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 which is applicable from the 25th May 2018, together with any domestic laws subsequently enacted.

I am notified as a Data Controller with the Office of the Information Commissioner under registration number ZA345355 and I am the data controller of any personal data that you provide to me.

The Data Protection Officer is Pamela Brickwood.

How I collect information from you and what information I may collect

I collect information about you:

- From your application for accommodation in the Holiday Homes or pitch in the Caravan and Motorhome Site
- From your contact information

I collect the following information about you:

- names, email address, dates of birth (as the Holiday Homes and Caravan and Motorhome Site are adult only), address, telephone number, pets (for the booking and for track and trace);
- car/ caravan/ motorhome details including number plate and if electric;
- Caravan and Motorhome Club (CAMC) Membership number (Caravan and Motorhome Site is CAMC members only); and
- Bank account details including account number and sort code.

Why I need this information about you and how it will be used

I need your information and will use your information:

- to undertake and perform our obligations and duties to you in accordance with the terms of our Licence to Occupy in the Holiday Homes or Booking Confirmation in the Caravan and Motorhome Site with you;
- to enable me to supply you with the services and information which you have requested;
- to help you to manage your stay;
- to carry out due diligence on any prospective guest;
- to analyse the information I collect so that I can administer, support and improve and develop our business and the services I offer;
- to contact you in order to send you details of any changes; and
- for all other purposes consistent with the proper performance of our operations and business.

Sharing of Your Information

The information you provide to me will be treated by me as confidential and will be processed only by any third party, acting on my behalf, within the UK/EEA.

I may disclose your information to other third parties who act for me for the purposes set out in this notice or for purposes approved by you, including the following:

- If I enter into a joint venture with or merge with a business entity, your information may be disclosed to our new business partners or owners;
- To carry out due diligence on you as a guest; and
- If you are unable to make payments under your stay, your information may be disclosed to any relevant party assisting in the recovery of this debt or the tracing of you as a guest.

Unless required to do so by law, I will not otherwise share, sell or distribute any of the information you provide to me without your consent.

Transfers outside the UK and Europe

I may transfer your information outside the UK. Where information is transferred outside the UK or EEA, I ensure that there are adequate safeguards in place to protect your information in accordance with this notice.

Security

When you give me information I take steps to make sure that your personal information is kept secure and safe. Information is kept in a folder and on an office computer which is password protected (inside my locked house).

How long I will keep your information

I review my data retention periods regularly and will only hold your personal data for as long as is necessary for the relevant activity, or as required by law (I may be legally required to hold some types of information), or as set out in any relevant contract I have with you.

Our full retention schedule is available in my office.

Your Rights

You have the right at any time to:

- ask for a copy of the information about you held by me in my records;
- require me to correct any inaccuracies in your information;
- make a request to me to delete what personal data of yours I hold; and
- object to receiving any marketing communications from me.
